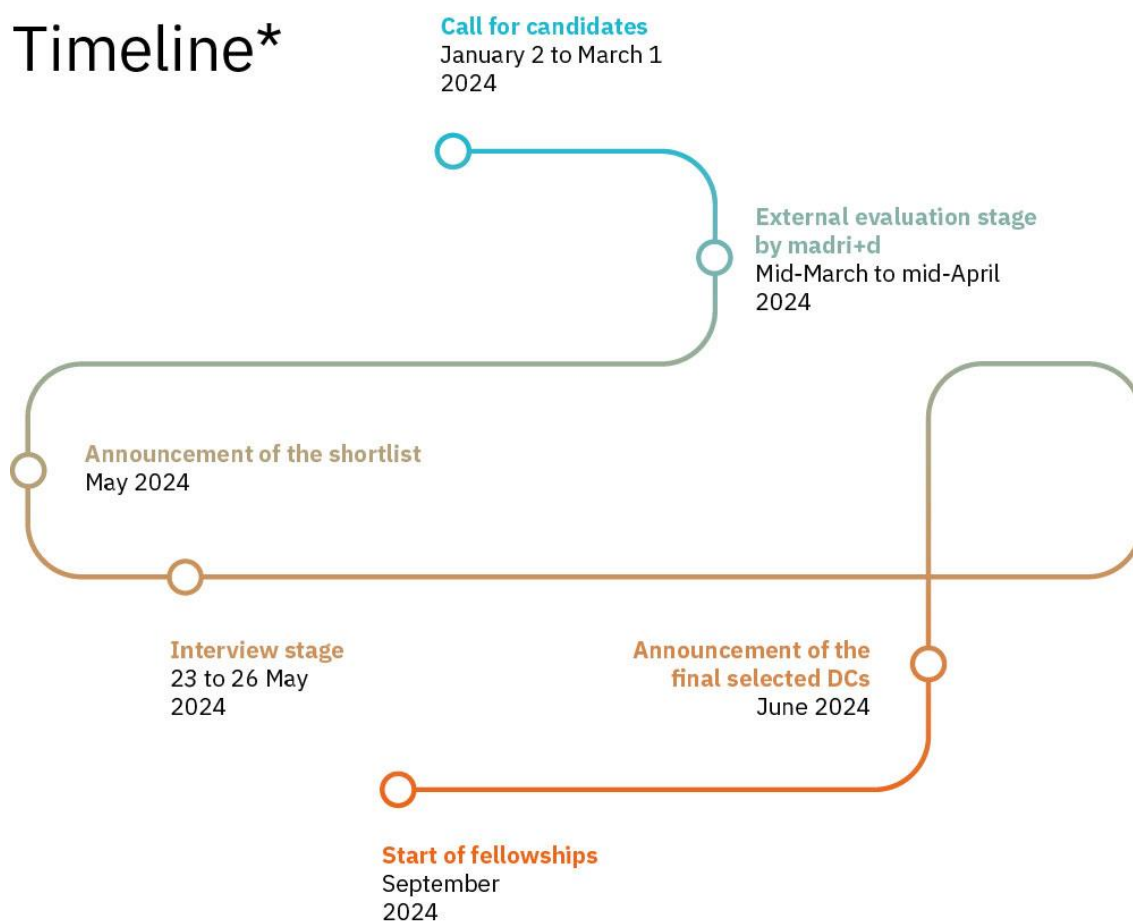

CarrerasPathfinders program is a new world-wide unique doctoral program, designed and led by the Josep Carreras Leukaemia Research Institute.

1. The aim of the program is to support 14 excellent Doctoral Candidates (DCs) for a period of 4 years. During this period, the selected researchers will engage in pre-selected research projects under the supervision of IJC research group leaders and conduct international secondments to academic and non-academic institutions.
2. The DCs will be enrolled in PhD programs at either the University of Barcelona (UB) or the Autonomous University of Barcelona (UAB).
3. The program covers the entire spectrum of research and innovation in blood cancers from understanding disease biology to the implementation of novel processes in the clinical practice.
4. By nurturing a diverse and highly skilled cohort of DCs, the program aims to equip them with unique skill sets through training by experts, collaborative research, and transfer of knowledge, boosting their effectiveness and capacity for innovation.
5. This innovative program, which has a triple-I dimension (internationality, inter-sectorality, and interdisciplinarity), will shape a new generation of researchers capable of addressing unmet needs and societal challenges in blood cancers.
